

**Walter K. Kell**, (19 Sep 1867 – 7 Jan 1917), Newspaper Clipping, 10 January 1917, The Perry Historians

Many friends in this place and especially in the upper end of the county will regret to learn of the death of **Walter K. Kell** of Newport, which occurred in the Presbyterian Hospital, Philadelphia, on Sunday evening from carcinoma. He had been ill for some years and an accident at the Oak Extract Works last may aggravated his condition.

The deceased was a son of the late **Henry** and **Katharine (Weaver) Kell** and was born in Tyrone Township, Sept. 19, 1867, and at his death was aged 49 years, 8 months, and 18 days. For eleven years he kept store at Cisna Run, and in 1914 went to Newport and kept the West End Grocery one year. He sold out to engage in outdoor employment.

The deceased is survived by his wife, who was **Margaret Walker**, and the following children: **Warren, Russell, Mildred**, and **Catharine** at home. His mother survives with the following brothers and sisters: **Benj. F.**, and **David Kell**, of Loysville; **Samuel** of Monmourth, Ill; **Elizabeth**, (**Mrs. Theophilus Miller**) of Loysville, and **Catherine**, (**Mrs. Melvin Mumper**) of Barberton, Ohio.

He was an excellent citizen and was a consistent member of the Reformed Church for many years.

Interment was made in Restland Cemetery Loysville this morning.
