

Thomas Stowe Kennedy, (1875 – 24 Sep 1957), Perry County Times, October 1, 1957

Thomas S. Kennedy, 82, died at his home, Loysville, R. D., September 24, following a brief illness.

A retired bricklayer, he was a veteran of the Spanish American War. He was a member of the Juniata aerie of the Fraternal Order of Eagles, Lewistown and a life member of the Blain Fire Co.
