

Isaac M. R. Kines, (11 May 1871 – 11 Jan 1917), Patriot, Saturday, January 13, 1917

Isaac M. Kines, 45 years old, a prominent Mason of Wilmington, Del., and for twenty nine years identified with the Pullman Car company plant of that city, died Thursday at the home of his sister, **Mrs. S. M. Mitchell**, 533 Emerald Street.

Survivors are: Miss **Aline Kines**, **Mrs. J. I. Kerr** and **Mrs. C T. Rice**, Newport; **Mrs. J. C. Meminger**, **Mrs. J. K. Hull** and **Mrs. S. M. Mitchell**, Harrisburg, and one brother, **John W. Kines**, of Wilmington, Del.
