

**Ellen Darlington (Rice) Kistler**, (14 Jul 1866 – 28 Nov 1928), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

**Mrs. Ellen Kistler**, aged 62 years, who was a daughter of **William**. and **Emma (Hench) Rice**, of Juniata County and a granddaughter of **Mr.** and **Mrs. Jacob Hench** of Bridgeport, died at her home in Carlisle, Wednesday of cancer of the stomach. She was married to **John Kistler**, a son of **Mr.** and **Mrs. Jacob Kistler** of Elliottsburg, about 43 years ago. **Mr. Kistler** dying about 14 years ago. A number of years ago they lived on the **John Ritter** farm at Loysville...

They moved to Cumberland County 21 years ago where they owned a farm until buying the property in Carlisle where she died. She was a member of the Lutheran Church in Carlisle and a fine Christian woman.

She was the mother of five children all living, namely, **Lizzie**, of Camden, N.J.; **Homer**, on a farm in Cumberland County; **Edna, Mrs. Burkett**; and **William**, of Carlisle and **Nettie**, at home. Also surviving are 7 grandchildren and the following sisters and brothers, **Mary, Mrs. Markel** of Iowa; **Sara, Mrs. Landis** of Juniata County; **Josephine, Mrs. Samuel Walker**, of Mechanicsburg; **Benjamin Rice**, of Harrisburg; **Edwin Rice**, of Lemoyne, and a step mother, **Mrs. Annie Hoffman Rice**, who lives with her step son **Benjamin Rice** of Harrisburg.... Interment was in the Letort Cemetery near Carlisle.
