

Henry Kitner, (4 May 1832 – 12 Apr 1914), Patriot, April 17, 1914, Harrisburg, PA; Perry County Veteran Dies From Paralysis

New Bloomfield, April 16 – **Henry Kitner** died yesterday at the home of his son, **Frederick**, in Carroll Township from the effects of paralytic stroke which he suffered last Thursday. He was the son of **John** and **Sarah R Kitner**, and was the last of a family of thirteen brothers and sisters. His wife, whose maiden name was **Eliza Petrie**, died some years ago. He is survived by seven children, **Frederick Kitner**, at whose home he died; **Mrs. Mary Cooper** and **Mrs. Rose Foose**, all of Carroll Township, and **David, William, Samuel** and **Jesse Kitner** in the West.

He was a veteran of the Civil war. He was for eleven months a prisoner in Andersonville. Funeral services will be held on Friday morning and will be conducted by the Rev. G. W. McIlroy, of the Methodist Church of this place. He was a member of John Jones Post, G.A.R. of New Bloomfield. He was eighty-two years old.
