

Minnie Jane (Sheibley) Kitner, (15 Dec 1871 – 4 Dec 1933), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians, **Mrs. Fred Kitner**

Minnie Jane (Sheibley) Kitner passed away at the home of her daughter, **Mrs. Charles Martin**, in Carlisle on Monday, December 4, at 4 p.m., after a short illness from a complication of diseases.

She had been apparently as well as usual and attended her household duties at her home, 1 1/2 miles north of Bloomsfield, until Friday, when her son **Maurice**, and daughter, **Carrie**, noticed she was ill. Monday morning, her son, **Wesley**, took her to her daughter's home, where she passed away that afternoon.

Mrs. Kitner was a daughter of **Mr. and Mrs. Peter Sheibley**, deceased, and was born near Elliottsburg, December 16, 1871, consequently she was aged 61 years, 11 months and 18 days. She was married to **Frederick B Kitner**, Sept. 15, 1894, who died November, 1931. She is survived by the following children; **Wesley M, John H, Mary (Mrs. Charles Martin)**, and **Laura (Mrs. John Martin)**, of Carlisle; **Maurice** and **Carrie**, of Centre township; two sisters, **Mrs. Henry Lickel**, of Blain, and **Mrs. Elizabeth Adair**, of Lancaster, and four grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at Mt Gilead Church at 2:45 p.m. tomorrow, Thursday.
