

Mrs. Mary Koons, (18 Jun 1830 - 19 Mar 1906), Patriot, Thursday, March 22, 1906

On Monday evening at 6.30 o'clock **Mrs. Mary Koons**, wife of **Jacob Koons**, died at her home, 201 Hummel Street, at the age of seventy-six. She had been ill for five months and her death was due to old age. Funeral services will be held this afternoon at the house at 1.30 o'clock by Rev. A. A. Kelley, pastor of Christ Lutheran Church. There will be a private interment at West Fairview Cemetery.

The pallbearers will be **Jacob L.**, **George W.**, and **J. Grant Koons**, sons of the deceased; **John A. Goodman**, a son-in-law, **Harold K. Goodman** and **Charles O. Koons**, grandsons.

Mrs. Koons was born in Markelville, Perry County, June 18, 1830. She was married to **Jacob Koons** in 1848 and soon after the couple removed to a place near West Fairview in Cumberland County. Here they remained until 1872, when they settled to the East of Harrisburg, remaining there until 1885; they came here, where they have resided ever since. Mrs. Koons has been for many years prominent in church work, being a consistent and devoted member of Christ Lutheran Church. She is survived by her husband, **Jacob Koons**, aged eighty-two years and the following children: **Miss Katherine E. Koons**, **Jacob L. Koons**, **Mrs. Margaret E. Goodman**, **George W. Koons**, **Mrs. Anna M. Alleman**, **Mrs. Quilla K. Zimmerman**, **J. Grant Koons**, ex-Common Councilman, Second Ward, and **Miss Dessa A. Koons**.
