**George Kunkle**, father of **Mrs. Brownawell**, was born in Perry County. In his youth he learned the shoe making trade, following it a number of years, when he engaged in farming, and thus continued until he was eighty years of age, when he retired. His death occurred in Middlesex Township four years later. He was a man of high standing in his community, and was sincerely respected. For his first wife he married **Sallie Rousch**, who died in Perry County, leaving the following children: **John; Eliza; Margaret; Sarah; George; Mary (Mrs. Brownawell); Adeline** and **Samuel** (twins), the latter killed during the Civil war. After the death of his first wife **Mr. Kunkle** married her sister, who bore him three children and died aged seventy. The children of the second union were: **Wilhelmina**, living at Greason; and **Levi** and **Albert H.**, who both died at Carlisle.
