

**John L. Kutz**, (3 Feb 1852 – 21 Mar 1931), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians, March 25, 1931

**John T. Kutz**, aged 79 years, died at his home near Carlisle Springs Saturday of a paralytic stroke. He was married in 1876 to **Miss Julia Lightner** a daughter of **Henry** and **Mary Stewart Lightner**, of Sheaffer's Valley and was a resident all his life in the vicinity in which he died. He was a butcher by trade and also a farmer and attended the Carlisle market. He is survived by his wife and three children: **John**, of Carlisle Springs; **Clara**, **Mrs. David Wetzel**, of Carlisle, and **Lila** at home; also by one grandson and the following brothers and sisters: **Geo. Kutz**, **Mrs. Mary Stone**, **Mrs. Ella Kitner**, of Carlisle; **Mrs. Wesley Hoy**, Cumberland County; **Joseph Kutz**, of Carlisle Springs; **Mrs. John Stone**, of Steelton.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 today (Wednesday) in the Carlisle Springs Lutheran Church which he was a member and burial will be in the mausoleum in Westminster Cemetery, near Carlisle.
