**Kenneth S. "Uncle Ken" Landis**, 78, of Newport, died Tuesday, February 25, 2003 at this home.

Born July 27, 1924 in Juniata Co., he was the son of the late **Samuel** and **Annie (Zellers) Landis**. His wife, Sandra J. (Davis) Landis, died on February 19, 1985.

He was a U.S. Navy Veteran, serving on the USS Antietam during World War II. He was the former owner of The Curve Restaurant, New Bloomfield, and a member of the Mifflintown VFW, Mifflintown American Legion, Thompsettown AMVETS, Newport Owl's Club and the Perry Alliance Church, Shermans Dale.
