Lauver. - **Elizabeth**, daughter of the late Bishop **William Auker** and member of the Lost Creek Mennonite Church near Oakland Mills, Pa., died April 5, 1942, after an illness of seven months; aged 82 y. 5 m. 29 d.

Her husband, **Jacob Lauver**, preceded her in death Feb. 24, 1933. One daughter (**Mrs. Banks Heckman**) died June 11, 1939. She is survived by two daughters (**Mrs. Prudence Bassler** and **Mrs. Raymond Coldren** of Mifflintown, Pa.), one son (**Owen B. Lauver** of Myersdale, Pa.), two sisters (**Mrs. Susan Oberholtzer** of New Holland, Pa., and **Maggie Auker** of Evandale, Pa.), nine grandchildren. and six great-grandchildren. Brief funeral services were held at the home of her daughter, Mr. and Mrs. **Raymond Coldren**, followed by services at the Lost Creek Church, in charge of Bro. Banks Weaver and Bro. Donald Lauver. Interment in Lost Creek Cemetery.
