Newport, Mar 1. – By the death of **James B. Leiby**, last night, Newport lost its oldest merchant. **Mr. Leiby** was born in Newport on May 11, 1836, and the seventy-eight years of his life were spent here. In 1861 he opened a general store at the corner of Markey and Canal Streets, from which time he has continued in business.
