

**Jane (Smith) Leiby** (1850 – 10 May 1913)

Mrs. **Jane Leiby**, beloved wife of Mr. **Elias B. Leiby**, died at her home in Marysville on Saturday. She had not been in good health for some time. She was 63 years of age.

The deceased was a daughter of the late **Mr. and Mrs. Henry L. Smith**, of Middle Ridge. She is survived by her husband and one son, **Scott Smith Leiby**, Esq., a member of the Perry and Dauphin county bars; also by two sisters, **Mrs. James B. Leiby** and **Mrs. John S. Roper**, of Newport, and one brother, **Willis L. Smith**, of Philadelphia, Pa.

**Mrs. Leiby** was a kind, devoted wife and mother and a lifelong member of the Reformed Church. She was a lady of fine character and amiable disposition and consecrated her life to her family and church. The funeral service was held yesterday afternoon, the services being conducted by the Rev. S.L. Flickinger, after which the remains were taken to Newport for burial.
