

Charles Leighton Lenney (23 Jan 1878 – 4 May 1922)

Charles L. Lenney, 47, died Thursday evening at his home, 440 Hummel street, Harrisburg after several months illness of Bright's disease.

Deceased was a son of **Mr. and Mrs. J.M. Lenney**, deceased, and was born and reared in Newport, before going to Harrisburg a number of years ago.

He is survived by his widow and 12 years old son, Mrs. Lenney, before marriage being **Nellie Baxter** of Rye Township.
