

Frank W. Lentz, (Died 3 Dec 1915), Patriot, Saturday, December 4, 1915, Burgess **Lentz**, of Marysville, Dies

Marysville, Pa., Dec 3. – **Frank W. Lentz**, burgess, who for twenty-five years was also constable here, and a veteran of the Civil War, died at his home this morning.

Mr. Lentz was 75 years old. He was born in Loganville, York County, and came to this place 31 years ago. He worked for the Pennsylvania railroad company in the shops here for 17 years, having to retire at that time on account of his poor health. Four years ago **Mr. Lentz** was elected chief burgess, which office he held at the time of his death; his term expiring next month.

He was a member of the Red Men Tribe, No. 331, of Harrisburg and of the G.A.R. Post 116.

Funeral services will be held at his late home on Monday afternoon at two o'clock. The Rev. C. A. Parson, pastor of the Church of God will officiate, assisted by the Rev. L. A. Fuhrman, pastor of the United Evangelical Church. Burial will be made in the Chestnut Grove Cemetery at this place.
