Duncannon Brakeman Killed

Special to The Inquirer – Lewistown, Pa., Aug. 17. – **John W. Liddicks**, 48 years old, of Duncannon, Pa., employed as a brakeman on the Pennsylvania Railroad, was instantly killed by Train No. 23 in the local yards at midnight. The train on which **Liddicks** was employed was shifting cars and in stepping out of the way he walked into the approaching passenger train.
