Ralph I. "Ralphie" Lindsay, 86, of Liverpool, entered into rest on Wednesday, July 28, 2010 at Holy Spirit Hospital, Camp Hill.

Mr. Lindsay was born on October 17, 1923 at the family home in Hunters Valley, Liverpool, the son of the late **James Irvin** and **Matilda Jane (Brubaker) Lindsay**.

He attended Hunters Valley Grammar School. On March 17, 1945 he married the former **M. Evelyn Shutt**, who survives. His passing breaks a loving marital union of 65 years.

Ralph began his employment with the Pennsylvania Railroad, and retired from Central Storage & Transfer Co. of Harrisburg. He also served as the Buffalo Twp. Supervisor for 40 years.

Mr. Lindsay was a member of the Bucks Valley United Methodist Church, Newport and the Hunter's Valley Sportsman's Association. Ralph enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening, farming and caring for his horses.
