

**Kirk Haines Lobaugh**, (4 Aug 1860 – 25 Jul 1898), Daily Republican, Decatur, IL, July 26, 1898

**K. H. Lobaugh** died of consumption at 7:30 p. m. Monday at his home, 186 East Jefferson Street, aged 38 years. He leaves a wife and three children. The deceased was a member of Decatur Camp, No. 141 M. W. of A. and has many friends in the city. For many years he was employed as a horseshoer for Nicholas, the blacksmith but a year ago his health became so poor that he was obliged to give up his work. Last winter he was sent to Florida by the Woodman camp, but the trip did not benefit him. Monday morning he was given the Murphy treatment, but his case was too far advanced to be benefited in that way. The time of the funeral has not yet been decided upon.
