LIVERPOOL - **Richard Wayne Long**, 71, formerly of Liverpool and Newport, passed away on December 21, 2006 at Stonebridge Health and Rehabilitation in Duncannon, where he was a resident for several years.

Richard was born in Liverpool Township, October 23, 1935, to the late **Kenneth and Janet (Ulsh) Long**.

He was a graduate of Greenwood High School, served in the U.S. Army, was a former member and chairman of the Perry County Republican Committee, a Perry County Commissioner, Perry County Chief Assessor, established the Fiscal Department for Perry County, was a former member and treasurer of the Millerstown Fire Department, worked for the Commonwealth of PA, in the Bureau of Administrative Services and was a Jury Commissioner of Perry County.
