

Lee Edward Loper, (5 Apr 1928 – 30 May 2015), Perry County Times, June 13, 2015



Lee Edward Loper, 87, originally of Duncannon, died Saturday, May 30, 2015, at his home in New Bloomfield.

He was born April 5, 1928, in Duncannon to **Samuel** and **Pearl (Durham) Loper**.

He worked for construction companies for more than 50 years; was an Army veteran, serving during World War II; a member of American Legion Post 340, Duncannon, and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 225, where he served as past commander.

He was the widower of **Clara Elizabeth (Blaine) Loper**, who died April 1998.

Surviving are two sons, **Thomas L.** of Duncannon and **Donald C.** of New Bloomfield; a sister, **Janet A. Harris** of Lewistown; and several grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
