

Frederick W. Lupfer, (29 Mar 1882 – 17 Dec 1930), Altoona Mirror, December 17, 1930

Residing in the Mayo Apartments, Union Avenue and Seventeenth Street and employed as a locomotive engineer on the Pittsburgh Division of the Pennsylvania Railroad, died at the Altoona Hospital at 3:25 o'clock this morning of pneumonia. He was admitted to the institution at 12:30 o'clock Sunday morning.

Deceased was a son of **Henry** (deceased) and **Emma Lupfer** and was born at New Bloomfield, Perry County, March 29, 1882. He had been a resident of this city for twenty-five years.

Mr. Lupfer is survived by his wife, **Mrs. Theresa Lupfer** and by his aged mother and a brother, **Benjamin B. Lupfer** of New Bloomfield. He was a member of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers. The body was prepared for burial by C. B. Lafferty & Son, morticians, and the body may be viewed there until the time for the funeral, not yet set.
