Conner**, a native of Augusta Co., Va.; have had nine children, five of whom are living; came to this county in 1857, and settled in Marietta. He still resides in the township, and his P. O. Marietta. Has taught school in the winter for 40 years,—4 to 5 years in the same district,—evidence of popularity. His father, **Samuel**, was a native of Pennsylvania, a farmer, and died in 1871.
