DUNCANNON -- **Marie H. "Nuncy" Mader**, 75, a former Duncannon borough councilwoman, died Wednesday in the Masonic Homes, Elizabethtown.

"She was a very nice person," said former Borough Manager Thomas Evans, who held that post when Mader served on council. "She was right in there with the business, [knew] what was going on."

"I had known her for years," Evans added. We went to school together; she was a year behind me."

Mader was a former Republican committeewoman; a member of Asbury United Methodist Church, American Legion Auxiliary Unit 340, the Duncannon High School Alumni Association and Duncannon Senior Citizens; and a former member of Shermanata Grange 1796.

She was the widow of **Charles A. Noye**. Surviving are her husband, **William D. Mader**; a son, **Fred C. Noye** of Elliottsburg; two stepsons, **William D.** of Harrisburg and **Richard E.** of Bernville; a stepdaughter, **D. Patricia Reilly** of Winter Haven, Fla.; two grandsons; six stepgrandchildren; and five step-great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday in Smith Funeral Home.

Burial will be in Evergreen Cemetery, Duncannon. Visitation will be from 10 to 11 a.m. Saturday in the funeral home.
