**Albert L. Magee**, 79, of 326 New Bloomfield Road died Monday in Polyclinic Medical Center, Harrisburg.

He was the founder of **Magee Brothers Press**; was a retired employee of Triangle Press Inc., Harrisburg; was a member of Otterbein United Methodist Church and a member and former teacher of its men's Bible class; and was a member of Duncannon Fire Company; Perry County Historical Society; Duncannon Sportsmen's Club; Wagon Wheel Rod and Gun Club; Knights of Pythias Lodge, Marysville; Perry Lodge 458, F&AM, Marysville; Harrisburg Consistory; Newport Royal Arch Chapter 238; Planning Commission of Perry County; Pennsylvania State Grange; National Grange; past master and chaplain of Pomona Grange, where he was Granger of the Year in 1983; past master of Shermanata Grange 1796; secretary-treasurer of the Pennsylvania Nut Growers Association for 13 years, and editor of the Nut Kernel publication; past president of Duncannon Lions Club; and a life member of the National Rifle Association.

Surviving are his wife, **D. Helen Magee**; two sons, **Nevin S.** and **Charles E.**, both of Duncannon; two brothers, **Boyd A.** of New Bloomfield, and **Clyde H.** of Front Royal, Va.; and four grandsons.
