

**Richard L. Magee**, (1817 – Dec 1899), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

**Richard L. Magee**, cabinetmaker, farmer and school teacher from 1839 to 1866, died at his home in Center Township on Tuesday morning aged 82 years. He was the first teacher in the old log school house at Comp's in Center Township. He served as justice of the Peace in Carroll and Center Township. He was born in Adams County, and was married in 1841 to **Miss Margaret Black**. He was the father of nine children to his first wife, six of whom are dead. The following survived him; **John W.** and **Stephen A.**, of California, and **Mrs. James F. Roth**, of Colorado.

His wife died in August 1869. He was married March 3, 1870, to **Miss Mahala Morton**. The fruit of this union was three children, **Florence** and **Charles**, at home and **Morton**, of Allegheny.

He as a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church over 60 years, a class leader and Sunday school superintendent. The funeral will be held tomorrow morning at 10:30 o'clock: services in the Bloomfield Methodist Episcopal Church, and interment in the Old Graveyard of that place.
