

Martha H. (Hetrick) Mandeville, (9 May 1864 – 10 Feb 1949) Newspaper Clipping,

Winnebago, Feb. 11. – **Mrs. Martha H. Mandeville**, 84, lifelong Winnebago County resident, died last night in her home after a long illness.

A former school teacher, Mrs. Mandeville attended Wells Teacher's training school, Oregon, and was graduated from Rockford College in 1881. She taught in Edwardsville from 1881 until her marriage to the late Thomas Mandeville in 1887. Her daughter, **Miss A. Dorothy Mandeville** has been principal of the R. K. Welsh and P. R. Walker schools in Rockford since 1936.

Mrs. Mandeville was born May 9, 1864, near Byron, the daughter of **Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Hetrick**. She was a member of the Winnebago First Presbyterian Church, the Winnebago Reading Circle and was active in Missionary work. Also surviving are another daughter, **Mrs. Stella**

Armstrong, Long Beach,, Cal.; a son, **Thomas E.**, Winnebago; nine grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.

Private services will be held at 4 p. m. Saturday in Winnebago Presbyterian Church. The Rev. L. R. Gilfume will officiate, and burial will be in Winnebago Cemetery.
