

Josiah R. Manning, (1844 – 18 Aug 1903, Patriot, August 20, 1903 Josiah Manning Dead, Special Telegram to the Patriot.

Duncannon, Aug. 19. – **Josiah R. Manning**, a well known citizen of this place, died at 1 o'clock this morning from cancer of the stomach, with which he had been sick since May. He was fifty-seven years of age and was a native of Duncannon. He was a Civil War veteran and was a member of Post 196 of the Grand Army of the Republic.

The funeral services will take place at 2 o'clock on Friday and the pastor of the Marysville Church of God will officiate. Interment will be made in the Methodist cemetery.

Mr. Manning is survived by a widow, five daughters and three sons: **Mrs. Alexander Shatto** of Harrisburg; **Mrs. Simon Perry**, **Mrs. Thomas McCann**, **Mrs. William Fissel** and **Mrs. Raymond Guyler**, of Duncannon, and **Albert**, **William** and **Josiah Manning**.
