David E. Markle, 87, of Millerstown died Saturday, Oct. 31, 2009 at Kinkora Pythian Home, Duncannon.

He was born Aug. 16, 1922 in Seven Stars, Juniata County, to the late **Charles R. Sr.** and **Vida I. (Sarver) Markle**.

He began employment with the Farm Bureau and retired as a mail carrier from the U.S. Postal Service; was a 1940 graduate of Millerstown High School; an Army Air Corps veteran of World War II, discharged on July 15, 1943; formerly attended the Presbyterian Church of Perry Valley (formerly Wright's Presbyterian Church) and was attending St. Matthew Lutheran Church, Millerstown; a member of Liverpool American Legion Post 364, Disabled American Veterans Newport Chapter 49, Perry County Grange 1804 and Susquehanna Valley Sportsmen's Association; and enjoyed farming, stamp collecting and the outdoors.

He was the widower of **Mildred M. (McGowan) Markle**, who died June 17, 2009.

Surviving are a son, **James** of Harrisburg; six grandchildren, **Christine Markle**, **Karen Steele**, **Teresa Markle**, **Daniel Markle**, **Kelly Markle** and **Curtis Markle**; and a brother, **Charles Jr.** of Millerstown.

He was preceded in death by a son, **Harry**, and two sisters, **Ruth Maneval** and **Pauline Rhoades**.

A memorial service, with a flag presentation by American Legion Post 364, was held Nov. 7 in St. Matthew Lutheran Church with Pastor James Westgate officiating.
