

**Dr. Robert C. Marshall**, (29 Jan 1841 - 11 Oct 1911), Patriot, Friday, October 13, 1911; **Dr. Robert C. Marshall**, Of West Fairview, Dies Of Stroke Was Born in Newport, Graduated From Jeff and Served in Army

Following a stroke of paralysis on Sunday morning, **Dr. Robert C. Marshall**, aged 71 years, one of the best known physicians of Cumberland County, died at his home at West Fairview, Wednesday night.

**Dr. Marshall**, who was born in Newport, Perry County, received his early education in the public schools of that place. Afterwards he entered Jefferson Medical College at Philadelphia and received his diploma from this institution. At the outbreak of the Civil War he enlisted in a company formed in Perry County and was made surgeon of the regiment. At the close of the war he practiced at New Buffalo and later at Halifax and moved to West Fairview where he has since resided and built up a large practice.

He is survived by four children, **Mrs. C. M. Fager**, of this city; **Mrs. Charles Disney**, of West Fairview; **Charles G. Marshall**, of Philadelphia, and **William S. Marshall**, of Philadelphia. The funeral will be held on Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. A. G. Wolfe, pastor of West Fairview Lutheran Church officiating. Interment will be made in Enola Cemetery.
