

Jon A. Mason, (14 Sep 1945 – Dec 2010), Perry County Times, Monday, January 6, 2011

Jon A. “Wolf” **Mason**, 65, died recently.

He was born Sept. 14, 1945 in Cortland, N.Y.

Surviving are his mother, **Vivian Mason** of Fayetteville; his spouse, **Beverly Mason** of Bradenton, Fla.; his longtime girlfriend, **Sherry Sears** of Newport; a brother, **Donald** of Gettysburg; a sister, **Sharon Griffie** of University Park, Fla.; three daughters, **Torrene Sears** of Newport, **Cindy Mason Capner** of Farmers Branch, Texas, and **Lori Silva** of Newton, N.J; nine grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his father, **Francis Mason** of Cortland, N.Y.

He was the owner and operator of four locations of Machine Heads Tattoo Shop; belonged to many organizations, including ABATE of Pennsylvania, Smithsonian Institute and Pagan Motorcycle Club, and had dedicated his life to motorcycling and the biker lifestyle; enjoyed fresh and salt water fishing and had owned and operated the Bradenton Beach Bait and Tackle Shop for many years; a self-taught horticulturalist; submitted numerous items of invention to the U.S. Patent Office; and after serving in the Army in Germany from 1965 to 1967, he pursued religious studies and was ordained as a Baptist minister.

A memorial service was held Dec. 28 in Zimmerman-Auer Funeral Home, Harrisburg. Burial was in Cortland, N.Y.
