Warren G. Matter, 83, of Liverpool died Wednesday, Nov. 16, 2011 at Nipple Convalescent Home, Liverpool.

He was born May 6, 1928 in Loganton to the late **Wilbur** and **Armina (Stamm) Matter**.

He began his employment with Forrer Garage in Duncannon and later with Robert “Bob” Register Garage in Liverpool until he bought the business in 1955 and named it Matter’s Garage, retiring in 1994; was a graduate of Montoursville High School; an Army veteran of the Korean War; a member of Liverpool American Legion Post 364, Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd, Liverpool, life member of Liverpool Fire Company and Ambulance League, and formerly associated with Perry Valley Sportsmen’s Club; and enjoyed cars and reading.

He was the widower of **Mary H. “Mick” Matter**, who died March 12, 2008.
