Emilie P. Maxton, 91, formerly of Ickesburg, died Tuesday, Nov. 1, 2011 at Stonebridge Nursing and Rehabilitation, Duncannon.

She was born March 16, 1920 in Downingtown to **Jesse W.** and **Mary (Crosby) Pollock**.

She was certified to teach English, French, Latin and German; a 1937 graduate of West Chester High School and a 1941 honor graduate of Ursinus College; a member of Faith United Church, Ickesburg, and had been active in the former Ickesburg United Church of Christ and its ladies guild; and enjoyed reading, cooking and dairy farming.

She was the widow of **Ellsworth Maxton**, who died in 1995.

Surviving are four children, **Jesse W. Maxton** of Mifflintown, **Norman G. Maxton** of Ickesburg, **William E. Maxton** of Duncannon and **Susan M. LeFebvre** of Harleysville; a sister, **Ruth Woods** of Woodland Hills, Calif.; six grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

Services were held Nov. 4 in her church. Burial was in Windsor Baptist Church Cemetery, Eagle, Pa.
