Ermon P. Mayfield, 87, of New Bloomfield died Tuesday, Jan. 10, 2012 at Carolyn Croxton Slane Hospice Residence, Harrisburg.

He was born April 1, 1924 in Louisville, Ky., and grew up in Brodhead, Ky.

He was a printer and photographer and retired from the former Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources; a Navy veteran of World War II, serving on the USS New York and in North Africa; had many hobbies throughout his life, including gem and mineral hunting, classical guitar, photography and photo retouching, crafting, painting and pastel artwork; and enjoyed spending weekends in the family cabin in the woods in western Perry County.
