

Carrie May (Raffensperger) McBride, (8 Aug 1873 -Sep 1899), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Carrie May, wife of **John M. McBride** and daughter of **G.D. Raffensperger**, of Juniata Township, this county, died of typhoid fever at 4 o'clock last Friday morning at her home in Alverton, Westmoreland County, Pa. She had been confined to bed one week, although ailing for some time. She was born in Juniata Township this county, August 8, 1873, and was married to **Mr. McBride** seven years ago. They subsequently resided in Altoona and Alverton about 18 months in the latter place.

Three children survive her. They, with their father, her brother, **Harry L. Raffensperger**; the late **Mrs. Raffensperger's** friends, Mrs. M.F. Yoder, and Mrs. Mary Gossard, all of Alverton, accompanied the corpse to this place (Newport) Tuesday afternoon at 2:24 o'clock. It was taken thence to Markelville for interment. Funeral services were conducted in the Lutheran Church there by Rev. J.M. Axe.

The late **Mrs. McBride** is survived by her **father** and **mother**, and the following brothers and sisters; **Orrie S.** and **Price O. Raffensperger**, of Altoona; **Austin**, of Bailysberg; **Harry L.** of Alverton; **Warren G.** and **Millard F.** at home; Misses **Annie O.** and **Tamar S.** at home.
