William McIlvain Dead,

Special to the Inquirer. Reading, Nov 9. – **William McIlvain**, a well known iron manufacturer of this city, and head of the firm of **McIlvain & Sons**, died suddenly this afternoon, aged 80. He had been in the iron business since 1835 and established large works in this city, at Gibraltar, Berks County, and Duncannon, Perry County. He was president of the Second National Bank since its institution, and was connected with many local enterprises. He leaves a **widow**, three **sons** and one **daughter**.
