

Elmira (Culp) McKay, (Died 19 Jul 1904), Patriot, Thursday, July 21, 1904; Died In Her Rocking Chair – **Mrs. Elmira McKay** Succumbed Suddenly at Her Home.

While sitting in her rocking chair in front of her home, **Mrs. Elmira McKay**, aged fifty years, died Tuesday evening at 7:30 o'clock. Just before her death she performed an act of kindness in giving a gift to a friend.

Mrs. KcKay was born in Duncannon but moved to this city while quite young. Until last December, **Mrs. McKay's** health had been very good, but then she began to fail slowly, though it was not necessary for her to take to her bed.

The funeral services will be held at her home to-morrow afternoon at 3 o'clock and will be in charge of Rev. George R. Hoverter, pastor of the Nagle Street Church of God, assisted by the Rev. Ellis N. Kremer, pastor of the Reformed Salem Church. Interment will be made in the Harrisburg Cemetery. She is survived by ten children. She is survived by two brothers, **Noah** and **George Culp**, and two sisters, **Annie Culp**, and **Mrs. Harry Zimmerman**.
