

**Sylvester McKay**, (Died 30 May 1914), Patriot, Monday, June 1, 1914; Life Long City Resident, Dies

**Sylvester McKay**, a life-long resident of this city, died Saturday night at the home of his daughter, **Mrs. Daisy Freis**, 1251A Market Street, aged 63 years. Death was due to a complication of diseases, from which he was ailing for the last year. He was confined to his bed for the last six weeks.

**Mr. McKay** was born in Duncannon, but came to this city in his early boyhood. For many years he was employed as a puddler at Bailey's Mills, remaining there until the plant was closed, five years ago.
