

Catherine Sourbeer (Hess) McKenzie, (22 Jan 1864 – 10 Apr 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, April 18, 1935

Mrs. Catherine Hess McKenzie, aged 70 years, widow of the **Dr. Horace W. McKenzie**, died in the Keystone Hospital, Harrisburg, where she had been admitted the day previously, suffering of a heart condition. Her husband preceded her in death five years ago.

She was a daughter of the late **Mr. and Mrs. Abraham Hess** and was born and reared at Safe Harbor, Lancaster County locating here with her parents more than a half century ago, when **Mr. Hess** became manager of the Duncannon Iron Company store. She was a member of the Methodist Church in which she was very active until the time of her last illness. She was a director in the Peoples National Bank, and was keenly interested in civic affairs and in all matters relating to the home community to which she was intensely loyal. Her absence will be greatly missed in the church and community in general. She is survived by two sisters, **Mrs. Charles K. Laverty** and **Mrs. A. M. Lindsay**, of Harrisburg. A nephew, **Russell Lindsay**, of Harrisburg, also survives.

Funeral services were conducted at her late home Saturday afternoon, Rev. L. E. Shaffner, pastor of the local Methodist Church, officiating, interment was made in the Evergreen cemetery.
