

Mrs. **Emma J. (Magee) McVeagh**, (Died 4 Nov 1911), Patriot, Monday, November 6, 1911.  
Death of Mrs. Emma J. M'Veagh. Expired While in New Bloomfield on a Visit to regain her Health

New Bloomfield, Nov. 5. – Mrs. **Emma J. McVeagh**, of Williamsport, died yesterday morning at Mrs. Roath's boarding house. She had been in ill health for some months before she came here in June, suffering with heart trouble with kidney complications. The change seemed to benefit her, and for a time her health showed decided improvement. Several weeks ago, as she was preparing to return to Williamsport, she became worse and her decline was rapid until the end came. She was a native of this place, and a frequent visitor here, after her removal to Williamsport, and she had many friends and acquaintances here. She was a daughter of the late **Alexander** and **Sarah Magee**, and a sister of Hon. **John A. Magee**, for many years editor of the Perry County Democrat. She was married at her home here in 1866, to **Addis McVeagh**, who died many years ago. Two sons survive her, **Lee** and **Walter McVeagh**, of Williamsport. One sister survives, Miss **Sarah Magee**, of this place. She was an aunt of **Jas. S. Magee**, the present editor of the Democrat. Interment will be made at Williamsport.
