

Charles Smith Miller, (23 Mar 1875 – 28 Feb 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, March 7, 1935

Charles S. Miller, 59 years of age, and an employee of the Pennsylvania Railroad as a car inspector, died a his home, 1823 Forster Street, Harrisburg, Thursday, after an illness of almost two years duration.

Surviving are his widow, **Mrs. Ida E. Miller** and two sons, **John E. C. Miller**, proprietor of a store on Edwards Street, Harrisburg, and **Stewart**, at home; two daughters, **Mrs. Leo Salada**, Estherton, and **Mrs. Levi Horst**, Rockville; five grandchildren and one sister, **Mrs. Sarah Harder**, also survive.

Rev. J. E Whitacre, pastor of the Hummel Street Church of the Brethren, officiated. Burial was made In the East Harrisburg Cemetery. **Mr. Miller** was a former car inspector in the Marysville yards when run by the P. R. R.
