

**Clyde M. Miller**, (29 Sep 1931 – 2 Mar 2006), Perry County Times (New Bloomfield, PA) - Thursday, March 30, 2006

**Clyde M. "Soddy" Miller**, 74, of Shaffer Road, Millersburg, died Thursday, March 2, 2006 at home.

He was born Sept. 29, 1931 in Duncannon, a son of the late **Clyde M.** and **Harriet (Dressler) Miller**.

He retired from the Halifax Area School District as an elementary principal and also was a guidance counselor, and earlier was a social studies teacher and assistant football coach at Millersburg High School and guidance counselor and head football coach at Mahanoy Joint (Line Mountain) High School; a graduate of Duncannon High School, Mansfield State College and received a master's degree from Bucknell University, Lewisburg; an Army veteran during the Korean conflict; a member of Grace United Methodist Church, American Legion 326, Duncannon High School Alumni Association; and inducted into the Shamokin chapter of the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame in honor of his years of coaching football.

Surviving are his wife, **Joetta J. Walter Miller**; a son, **Michael** of Shermans Dale; two daughters, **Joetta Sunday** of Boiling Springs and **Susan Cooper** of Highspire; and six grandchildren, **Ashley** and **Tony Miller**, **Megan** and **Lauren Sunday**, and **Brian** and **Patrick Cooper**.

A memorial service was held March 7 in his church with the Rev. Floyd Sollenberger officiating. Burial was in Oak Hill Cemetery, Millersburg.
