

Meredith Loy Miller, (18 Aug 1915 - 10 Apr 1935), Duncannon Record, Thursday, April 18, 1935

Meredith Loy Miller, aged 18 years, died at the Harrisburg Hospital Wednesday night of last week at 10:40 o'clock, from injuries sustained when he fell from a tree at Island Park, Harrisburg, August 10, last, while watching a baseball game between the Harrisburg Senators and the House of David. His back was broken in the fall and he was completely paralyzed from the waist down. During his eight months' confinement at the hospital he was never able to leave the institution.

Deceased was a son of **Mr. and Mrs. C. E. Miller**, of the Cove, in addition to whom he is survived by the following brothers and sisters: **R. L. Miller**, Harrisburg; **E. C. Miller**, Wormleysburg; **S. R. Miller**, Prospect Park; **James, Jack and Charles Miller**, at home. **Mrs. E. W. Houtz**, Ridley Park; **Mrs. William Gelbaugh**, Shermansdale; **Leona, Charlotte and Landis**, at home.

Funeral services were conducted at his late home Sunday afternoon, Rev. H. P. Baker, pastor of the local United Brethren Church, officiating. The remains were taken to Newport where further services were held. Rev. H. S. Brumbaugh, pastor of the Methodist Church, officiating. Interment was made in the Newport cemetery.
