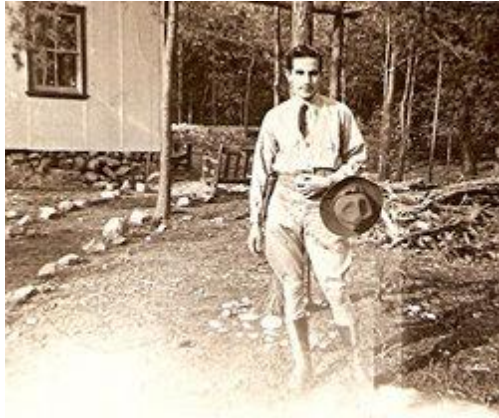


John Merritt Milliken, (5 Feb 1921 – 22 Sep 1943), Harrisburg Evening News, Friday, September 24, 1943; Hit By Crane in a Steel Mill Accident



Funeral services for **John M. Milliken**, Linglestown RD 1, who died Wednesday night of injuries suffered when struck by a crane hook at the Bethlehem Steel Company will be held at 3:30 p.m. Sunday at the Zimmerman home for funerals, Linglestown. The Rev. L. W. Klinefelter, of Wenrich's Lutheran Church will officiate. Burial will be in Willow Grove Cemetery, Linglestown. Friends may call between 7 and 9 p.m. tomorrow at the funeral home.

Milliken, who was 22 years old, died en route to Harrisburg Hospital in the steel company ambulance.

Death resulted from a fractured skull Acting County Coroner, Samuel B. Fluke said.

Surviving are his widow, **Mrs. Catherine N. Milliken**; one daughter, **Dianna Lea**, at home; his parents, **Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Milliken**, Progress; four brothers, **Walter B.**, Linglestown; **William H.** and **James A.**, both of Harrisburg, and **Luther G.**, Progress; and two sisters, **Miss Gertrude A. Milliken**, Progress and **Mrs. Eugene Maclay**, Rome N.Y.
