

Harry F. Mitten, (5 May 1932 – 5 Jul 2011), The Perry County Times, Saturday, July 16, 2011

Harry F. Mitten, 88, of Newville, died Tuesday, July 5, 2011 at home.

He was born May 5, 1923 in Perry County to **Russell** and **Grace (Jacobs) Mitten**.

He was an Army veteran, and prior to entering the armed services he was a farmer, later employed by the former Pennsylvania Railroad and Penn Central Railroad, and employed at the former Olmstead Air Force Base, Middletown, and Naval Inventory Control Point, Mechanicsburg, retiring from the maintenance department of the former Carlisle Hospital with 14 years of service; and during the last several years he enjoyed singing at area churches.

He was the widower of **Evelyn M. (Hykes) Mitten**, who died May 10, 2004.

Surviving are two daughters: **Millie Estrada** of Carlisle, Pa and **Bonnie Hess** of Loysville, Pa; a son: **Harry L. Mitten** of Harrisburg, Pa; a brother: **Russell Mitten** of Newville, Pa; 9 grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by three sisters, **Dorothy**, **Carrie** and **Doris**.

Services were held July 9 in Ronan Funeral Home, Carlisle, with the Rev. Paul Dunbar officiating. Burial was in Cumberland Valley Memorial Gardens.
