

Blake J. Morris, (Died 26 May 1940), Newspaper Clipping, The Perry Historians

Blake J. Morris, 1616 Hunter Street, Harrisburg, died Sunday afternoon, May 26, 1940 at his home. He was 47 years old. **Mr. Morris** was a member of the Modern Woodmen of America, Dillsburg.

Surviving are his widow, **Mrs. Dora Morris**; two sons, **William H. Morris**, Mechanicsburg, R. D. 4 and **Charles A. Morris**, at home; one grandchild; his parents **Mr. and Mrs. William H.
