

Ray Clifford Morris, (Died 25 Nov 1942), Harrisburg Telegraph, Friday, November 27, 1942

Services for **Ray C. Morris**, 28 South High Street, Duncannon, a railroad brakeman, who was instantly killed Wednesday night in the Enola Yards, will be at his home in Duncannon at 2 p.m. Saturday. The Rev. Raymond E. Fisher, Christ Lutheran Church, Duncannon, will officiate. Burial will be in the Evergreen Cemetery, Duncannon. Friends may call at the residence between 7 and 9 this evening.

A member of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, and the Duncannon Fire Company, he was 24 years old.

In addition to his widow, **Mrs. Emma**, he is survived by one daughter, **Sally Barbara**, at home, his mother, **Mrs. Frances Morris**, Duncannon; one sister, **Mrs. Elmer E. Harp**, Duncannon; and two brothers, **Carl**, Essex, Md., and **Donald L.**, Duncannon.
