William Thomas Morris practiced at Sunbury many years. He had previously served as surgeon in the United States Navy, and was a physician of experience and ability. Doctor Morris was born at Frederick, Maryland, January 8, 1783, and died at that place in December, 1834. He married Mary, daughter of Thomas and Deborah Grant, of Sunbury; she died on the 2d of April, 1842, leaving two children: Ann C, who was born at Sunbury, January 14, 1810, married Albert G. Bradford, of Elmira, New York, and died at Philadelphia, September 24, 1886; and Dr. Thomas G., who was born on the 11th of January, 1818, practiced medicine at Liverpool, Perry County, Pennsylvania, many years, and died at that place, March 28, 1887. As Doctor Morris' marriage occurred at Sunbury on the 27th of November, 1807, it is evident that his practice began at that place early in the present century.
