**William Thomas Morris** practiced at Sunbury many years. He had previously served as surgeon in the United States Navy, and was a physician of experience and ability. **Doctor Morris** was born at Frederick, Maryland, January 8, 1783, and died at that place in December, 1834. He married **Mary**, daughter of **Thomas** and **Deborah Grant**, of Sunbury; she died on the 2d of April, 1842, leaving two children: **Ann C**, who was born at Sunbury, January 14, 1810, married **Albert G. Bradford**, of Elmira, New York, and died at Philadelphia, September 24, 1886; and **Dr. Thomas G.**, who was born on the 11th of January, 1818, practiced medicine at Liverpool, Perry County, Pennsylvania, many years, and died at that place, March 28, 1887. As **Doctor Morris'** marriage occurred at Sunbury on the 27th of November, 1807, it is evident that his practice began at that place early in the present century.
