

Charles Everet Morrison, (28 Feb 1886 – 9 Jun 1941), Hagerstown Daily Mail, June 9, 1941, Hagerstown, MD

Charles E. Morrison died suddenly at his home at 432 Jefferson Street at 12:45 this morning, aged 56 years. He was a member of the Lutheran Church in Landisburg, PA.

He was an engineer on the Pennsylvania Railroad and had been living in Hagerstown for the past 28 years.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. **Minnie Morrison**; one daughter, **Mrs. Woodrow Clem**, of Hagerstown; three sons, **Clarence**, at home, **Chester**, at home and **Clayton Morrison**, of Hagerstown. One brother, **James Morrison**, Landisburg, Pa, and four sisters living at the place survive.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday afternoon at 2:30 from the Kraiss Mortuary Chapel. Interment to Rest Haven Cemetery.
