

**Walter E. Morrison**, (17 Jul 1893 – 21 Nov 1972), The Evening Sentinel, Tuesday, November 21, 1972, Carlisle, PA

**Walter E. Morrison**, 79, a former Cumberland County Nursing Home superintendent, of 1023 N. Pitt St., died early this morning in Carlisle Hospital.

He was born July 17, 1893, in Perry County and was a son of the late **Andrew** and **Annie Morrison**. He lived most of his life in Cumberland County.

He was married to the late **Fannie Keck Morrison**, who died in 1964. He is a former manager of the Shippensburg Office of the Cumberland County Farm Bureau, retiring after several years.

He served as superintendent of the Cumberland County Nursing Home from 1940 to 1945. Before going to the nursing home, he was a farmer in Middlesex Township for many years.

He was a member of the First Church of God, where he was a member of the Men's' Bible Class and the building committee. He was also a former member of the Church Council. He was a member of Carlisle Elks Lodge No. 578 for 23 years and was a member and treasurer of the Woodmen of the World.

Surviving are two sons, **Landis E. Morrison** and **Robert E. Morrison**, both of Carlisle; 3 sister, **Mrs. Pearl Rice**, Landisburg, **Mrs. Mary Keck**, Carlisle, and **Mrs. Miles (Edith) Dunkleberger**, New Bloomfield; and 3 grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 Friday in Ewing Brothers Funeral Home, 630 S. Hanover St., by the Rev. Paul Kocher, his pastor. Burial will be in Westminster Memorial Gardens.
